JESSIE ALLEY MEMORIAL SERVICE: Will be held on **Saturday, March 20th at 1 p.m.** There will be no reception.

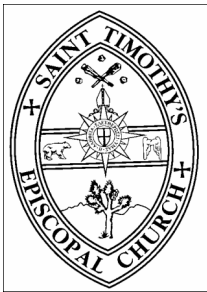
